If you are under 16 years old, we will need to talk to your parents or carers before any decisions can be made.



BUT we will still listen to you and respect your views and wishes.



Our service is impartial. This means we will not tell you what to do.

We will not take sides.



We will give you the information and support you need to make your own choices

Our service is confidential. That means we will only tell others if you want us to.
