The **Local Offer** is a way of finding out what **support** there is for you near **where you live**.

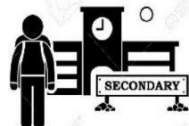


It may be on a **web page** or in a **leaflet**.

Families of children and young people with special educational needs



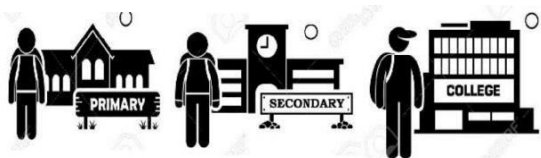
The **Information, Advice and Support Service** can help you find your Local Offer.
